NSU Chooses Miller to Lead Healthcare Division

National Specialty Underwriters Inc. (NSU) announced the hiring of Leslie Miller as senior vice president in charge of NSU Healthcare, a division of the company that specializes in the wholesale of medical professional liability to retail brokers nationwide.

Miller has 27 years of experience in sales, marketing, and management. Our optimism is based on the success we have had in recent years, by being one of only a handful of insurance wholesalers to specialize in medical malpractice insurance for hospitals, physicians, medical facilities, and long-term care at a time when the medical malpractice insurance industry is in great flux and needs reliable markets like NSU."
